General Confidentiality Statement:

As a general policy of privacy related to all information shared in each course, there is an expectation of confidentiality. This means that all personal information that is shared by others in small and large group interactions, in papers, discussion boards, in presentations, et cetera is not to be shared outside of the online and/or face-to-face classroom in any way without the permission of the person. *Violation of this policy may result in the student being dropped from the class and possibly further administrative disciplinary and/or legal action being taken.*
